Military Service Appreciation Grant

Bryan College is honored to support active duty personnel and veterans of the U.S. Military and their families in achieving their educational and career goals. The Military Service Appreciation Grant was instituted to help make educational opportunities more affordable for dedicated and capable students who have served or are serving in the U.S. Military, Reserves or National Guard.

Eligibility

To qualify for the Military Service Appreciation Grant, you must be a new or existing full-time student who enrolled on or after January 1, 2011 at Bryan College and be a veteran of the U.S. Military, Reserves or National Guard (including Army & Air Force Reserves, Coast Guard, Marine Corps Reserve and Army & Air National Guards) and have received one of the following:

- DD214 Certificate of Release or Discharge from active duty*
- NGB22 National Guard Report of Separation or Record of Service*

This grant is also available to active duty personnel in the U.S. Military, Reserves or National Guard who qualify for educational benefits under the Montgomery GI Bill, Post 9/11 GI Bill or the Reserve Educational Assistance Program (REAP).

Additionally, we are pleased to offer this benefit to spouses and children of veterans or active duty personnel (as defined above).

Grant Amount

If you meet the eligibility requirements above, you will receive a **\$500 tuition grant per academic year**, plus your registration fee will be waived. This grant is *in addition to* any financial assistance you are entitled to under the Montgomery GI Bill, Post 9/11 GI Bill, REAP or other state and federal financial aid.

Continued Eligibility

To remain eligible each academic year, you must maintain a 2.5 CGPA or higher, maintain full-time enrollment status and be continuously enrolled throughout the program of study.**
